

Bigfoot Sighting – Investigators Observing Sasquatch Running on All Fours

Details of Encounter:

This was the first of several evenings searching in a new location that we had often wondered about but had not had time to check out. We placed three apples in a row, approximately 10' apart, perpendicular to the position of our vehicle. The apples were approximately 40'-50' in front of the vehicle. We had our green ultraviolet lights on while using the dash cam. We decided to try this set up since we had not had any luck with the I.R. night vision in the past few months. We sat there quietly for over an hour thinking it would be another one of many uneventful nights. With my poor eyesight caused by advancing glaucoma, I tend not to say anything when I think I may have seen something. Instead, I rely on "Eagle Eye Dave" to make the first comment and verify in advance of whatever I thought I just observed.

All of a sudden, what I thought I saw was a bigfoot running from left to right in the unusual position of "being on all fours" which had never been observed by either one of us before. This of course happened very quickly, but I did notice that halfway across our view, his right arm extended far out in front of him, and he grabbed one of the three apples, not breaking his stride. I wanted to blurt out what I just saw, but for reasons just stated above, did not, just in case I imagined it. Instead, I waited approximately a minute hoping Dave would speak. At that point I became thoroughly disgusted with myself thinking that now I could no longer trust my eyesight and was starting to imagine things.

After another minute went by, as I sat there beating myself up, Dave suddenly spoke up. His words were my salvation. He said, "this is weird. Do you know what I thought I just saw?" At that point I very excitedly cut him off and said, "was it a bigfoot running from left to right on all fours and reaching out and grabbing one of the apples?" He looked over at me and said, "yes! Why didn't you say something?"

As we sat there and laughed about it, I told him that since he is the only one with good eyesight, he should have made the comment. This is another prime example of worrying about imaging things in the dark and not wanting to lose credibility. This was the fourth of our sightings in a five-year period, and all were most unusual. I can honestly say that I never thought I'd see a bigfoot running on all fours. Whether he let us see him or made a careless mistake, we will probably never know. The interesting part is that we reproduced that evening for the next three nights (approximately 3hrs/night) and never saw him run past us again. But even more amazing and impressive to understand was that with all the time spent there over the next three nights and us never taking our eyes off the apples for a second, we would both see one apple disappear at some point each evening. This was accomplished without any sign of what was taking the apple. It was a like a magic show, once more reminding us about how little we really know about the amazing abilities of bigfoot. We have so much to learn.
